This image was taken early in the morning on the Serengeti in Tanzania. Monkeys are one of my favorite subjects to photograph and the Vervet monkeys are very accommodating. I used a Canon 7d Mark II with a fixed Canon 500mm lens. Shutter speed 1/1250, ISO 800, f-stop- f10.

I had the opportunity to receive a media pass for photography to shoot photos at the 2025 Clovis Rodeo along with PRCA photographers.

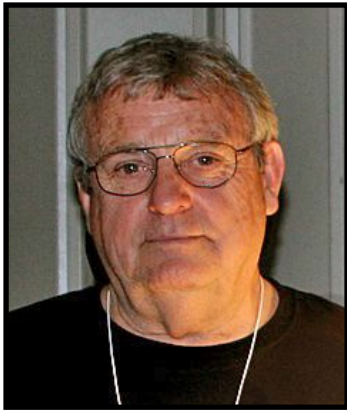


This photo was taken with my Nikon D850 using my 100-600 lens. Using auto focus was a must with the fast-moving pace of the bull riding. My ISO was set to auto and recorded at 3200. The exposure time was 1/5000 seconds with an aperture of 4.5.

Bulls tend to stay close to the chute they exit from which allows me to maintain a constant focal length.

My editing was done in Photoshop and Nik. Other than some color enhancing, sharpening and cropping, very little was done in the post processing of this photo.

This is one of many images captured at the Merced Wildlife Preserve. The attraction of the scene, for me, was the moodiness of the foggy conditions, soft light and the silhouetted trees in the background.

Equipment used was a Nikon D850 with a Nikkor 300mm, f/2.8, hand held. Settings were 1/2000 at f/2.8, exposure bias 1 EV, ISO 720 and of course focal length 300mm. Exposure program was manual and metering was Matrix.

Post processing consisted of using DxO Photolab to clean up the fog related noise with artistic adjustments completed in Photoshop and NIK software

PSA has a **Personalized Image Evaluation Service**. This service is especially helpful if the maker wants to have his/her skills evaluated, if the maker would like to know what constitutes an acceptable image in one of the PSA Divisions, or for pre-viewing Images before entering them in club competition or a PSA recognized Exhibition.

PSA also has an **Image Analysis Course**, which is helpful in judging ones own photos or becoming a certified judge.
