Colorful Bug

Colorful Bug: This shot was the result of a focus stack taken over this past Memorial Day weekend while camping. While hunting for something to shoot in a mountain meadow, I spied the little fly and did a four shot focus stack. I used a Fujifilm GFX100 with a Canon 90mm TS-E macro lens with an adapter. F/8, ISO 640 at 1/30s. The focus stack was put together in Helicon Focus software and processed thereafter in Photoshop. The colors remain true to to the circumstances and only contrast and a little saturation adjustments were made. The image was heavily cropped and then uprezzed with Topaz Gigapixel. If anyone recognizes what this colorful bug is, please let me know.

I took this at a little wildlife area on the way to work on a foggy morning back in Feb, 2019.

Fuji X-T2, f/13, 1/1000 sec, ISO-200, 164 mm (equiv to 246 mm) Single exposure, edited in Photoshop and Lightroom. Some increased exposure behind the birds and tree, darkened color around edges plus vignette. Minor water distractions were taken out.

Fuji X-T1, f/5.6, 1/500 sec, ISO-200 104mm (156 mm equiv) Along the blossom trail last March. I made minor adjustments in Photoshop and changed to a square crop.

These are free services offered by PSA to members. Need a Mentor? Go to


